



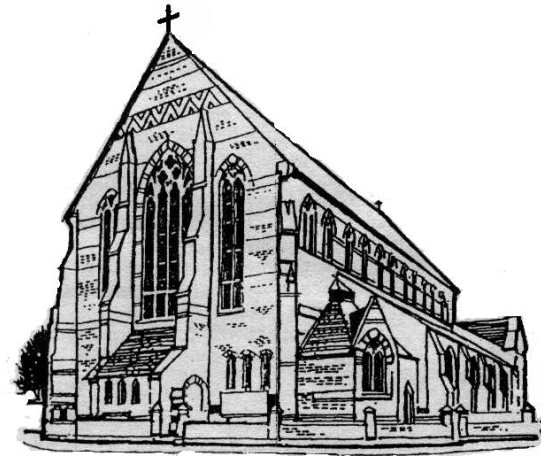
Micah 4: 1 – 5
