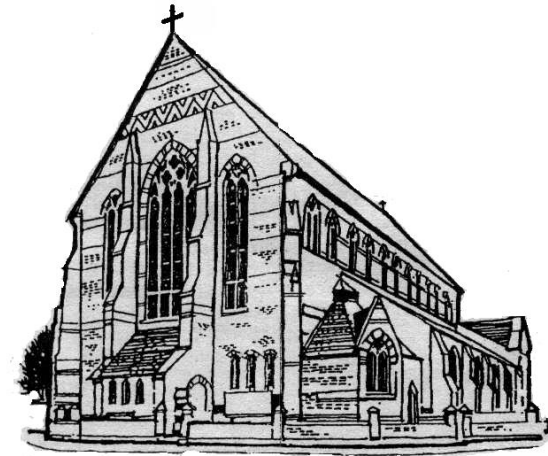




Romans 12: 9 - 21.
