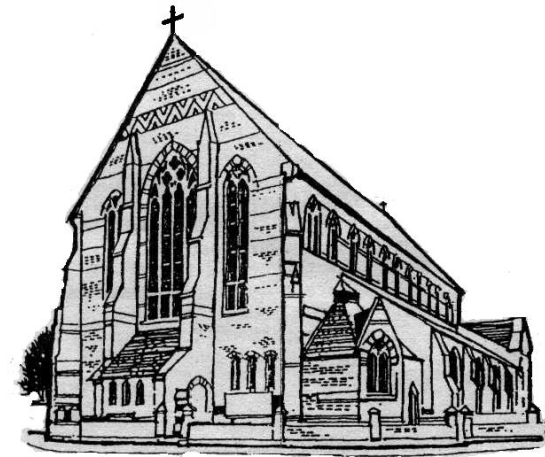
Prayers are needed especially on the following dates :-
